4th international exhibition of black & white photographs

»Portrait 2012«

1. The exhibition is conducted in accordance with the recommended practice of FZS and FIAP.
2. The exhibition is open to all photographers.
3. The themes of the exhibition are:
 - A. **portrait** including self-portraits, life-portraits and nude-portraits, but **not** classical portraits made in studio and portraits of animals;
 - B. **open**

In both themes **only black & white photographs** will be accepted.

4. Each author can send up to four (4) black & white photographs. The format of photographs is 30 x 40 cm, while the image itself may be any dimension or position within this format. All photographs should be **unmounted!**
5. FIAP's definition of a black & white photograph:
This definition supersedes the Document 223 and the INFO 1991/12.
A black and white work fitting from the very dark grey (black) to the very clear grey (white) is a monochrome work with the various shades of grey.
A black and white work toned entirely in a single colour will remain a monochrome work able to stand in the black and white category; such a work can be reproduced in black and white in the catalogue of a salon under FIAP Patronage.
On the other hand a black and white work modified by a partial toning or by the addition of one colour becomes a colour work (polychrome) to stand in the colour category; such a work requires colour reproduction in the catalogue of a salon under FIAP Patronage.
6. On the back of each photograph the name and address of the author, as well as the number of the photograph and its title, should be indicated, in accordance with data given on entry form.
7. All works will be judged by an international jury consisting of:
 - Mr Kurt Batschinski, Hon. EFIAP (Austria)
 - Mr Branislav Brkić, MF FSS, EFIAP (Serbia)
 - Mr Stojan Kerbler, MF FZS, AFIAP (Slovenia)
 - Mr Jure Kravanja, MF FZS, EFIAP (alternate member, Slovenia)

The decision of the jury will be final, with no appeal allowable.

8. Each participant should submit an entry form and pay the entry fee for catalogue and return postage in the amount of 15 EUR / 20 USD for one theme or 20 EUR / 25 USD for two themes. We do not accept cheques!
Entries without fee will not be judged or returned.
9. Please send your photographs, entry form and fee in a package that can be used for returning the photographs after the exhibition. All entries should be send by post to: FOTOKLUB LJUBLJANA, P.P. 4388, SI-1001 Ljubljana, Slovenia, with the heading »Portrait 2012«.
10. All photographs will be handled with utmost care; however we decline all responsibility in the case of loss, theft or deterioration during transit or during the exhibition.
11. By his signature on the entry form and his participation in the competition, the author expresses his agreement with the rules and authorizes the organizer to use his works for the promotion of the exhibition. The organizer undertakes to use the received personal data for the purposes of the exhibition only.
12. Results will be published on the home page of the Fotoklub Ljubljana (<http://www.fotoklub-ljubljana.si>). All participants will be also personally informed about the results.
13. Three FIAP medals and up to six FIAP ribbons will be awarded in each theme. Additionally a special award will be given to the best author. We reserve the right not to award all prizes.
14. All works will be returned to their authors, with enclosed catalogue of the exhibition, by the end of September 2012.
